

**Additional Entergy Comments on
DRAFT MOU BETWEEN NAESB AND NERC 10/15/02**

Entergy has already submitted two comments on the draft MOU. We would like to add the following suggestion to those two comments. The thrust of this suggestion concerns the continued coordination of standard development after the JIC process allocates standard requests to NERC or NAESB.

The authors of the MOU contemplate continued coordination through the statement in paragraph 2.6:

2.6 Once the JIC has assigned a proposed standard to one of the Parties, that Party's respective organization becomes the development authority. The development authority will then develop the proposed standard through its existing standards development process. The organization without development authority will assume an advisory-only role to the other organization, and is encouraged to actively participate in the development process by participating in subcommittee, task force and working group deliberations as well as offering comments and recommendations on any and all aspects of the proposed standard.

Entergy would like to see a greater commitment by each organization to give, and receive, advisory-only comments on draft standards being developed by the other organization. We would like to see this greater commitment reflected in this MOU.

This greater commitment could be reflected by each organization commissioning a subcommittee, or working group, charged to develop comments on standards being developed by the other organization. The NAESB group would develop comments projecting a commercial interest of reliability standards being developed by NERC, and the NERC group would develop comments projecting a reliability interest of commercial standards being developed by NAESB.
