

Arkansas Electric Cooperative comments on the NAESB-NERC-RTO/ISO MOU

I have several questions regarding the proposed MOU.

1. Why do the RTO/ISOs feel under represented in the current NERC and NAESB organizations?
2. What justification is there for them being a separate segment?
3. For representation in the JIC, why should they be represented by all three organizations?
4. Do the RTO/ISOs expect to have a vote in all three organizations represented in the JIC?
 - a. If so explain the fairness having representation in all three!
5. Why wouldn't it be fair for all other regulated entities to make the same claim for personal representation?
6. If the RTO/ISO council is to be the representative, why would all individual ISO/RTOs sign the MOU?
7. Will the MOU be subjected to full industry review? If not, why not.

In case my questions do not reveal my bias, I think the current proposal offers one segment of the industry representation that is not available to all segments of the industry.

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
