The "Bank" and "Draw" code values are associated with NGPL's new Interruptible Balancing Service. Though these codes may seem to appear similar to "Park" and "Loan", they are in fact in addition to traditional Park and Loan, and such quantities need to be discretely identified for scheduling and accounting purposes.

The "OFO" code value allows for identification of quantities nominated in response to an Operational Flow Order. As with the "Bank" and "Draw" code values, nominated OFO quantities need to be discretely identified for scheduling and accounting purposes.
