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**3. Description of Proposed Standard or Enhancement:**

Texas Eastern Transmission Corporation requests the creation of an EDI transaction set titled **Match Upload** and its corresponding validation transaction set, **Match Upload Quick Response**.

**4. Use of Proposed Standard or Enhancement (include how the standard will be used, documentation on the description of the proposed standard, any existing documentation of the proposed standard, and required communication protocols):**

The purpose of the upload transaction set is for a trading partner to be able to match a winning bid. The purpose of the quick response transaction set is for the transportation service provider to send validation regarding the match upload to the trading partner.

The creation of these EDI transaction sets is required so that users of the Texas Eastern Internet Web site will have access to the same information as users of EDI transactions. Texas Eastern is in the process of creating its interactive Web site and requests that this be processed as expeditiously as possible in order to facilitate electronic commerce via the Internet. These transaction sets, although requested by Texas Eastern, could be applicable across the pipeline segment.
