

Comments on 2003 REQ and RGQ Annual Plan Items 1 and 6 - Definitions

The following comments apply to both REQ and RGQ:

Baltimore Gas and Electric (BGE) supports the recommended language to complete the Introduction and Executive Summary Tabs in the REQ Creditworthiness Model Business Practices (MBP).

BGE also supports the recommended language for the RGQ MBPs, but notes some minor typos. Specifically:

1. In the Recommendation Summary, the phrase "Retail Electric Quadrant" should be replaced with "Retail Gas Quadrant".
2. In the second sentence of TAB 2 Introduction, the phrase "Retail Electric Quadrant" should be replaced with "Retail Gas Quadrant" and "(REQ)" should be replaced with "(RGQ)".
3. At the beginning of the third sentence, "(REQ)" should be replaced with "(RGQ)".
4. In the second sentence of the second paragraph of TAB 2, delete the stuck-through "in".
5. In TAB 3 Executive Summary under the heading "The Creditworthiness Evaluation Process", delete the stuck-through "of" in the first sentence.
