NAESB MASTER AGREEMENT FOR PURCHASE, SALE OR EXCHANGE OF LIQUID HYDROCARBONS WEB CAST COURSE

NAESB is pleased to announce a web cast course on the NAESB Master Agreement for Purchase, Sale or Exchange of Liquid Hydrocarbons (NAESB NGL Master Agreement) to be held on March 24th. The course is designed to review the NAESB NGL Master Agreement (WGQ Standard No. 6.3.5) and provide the attendees with a detailed understanding of the components of the contract. The NAESB NGL Master Agreement is similar to the NAESB Base Contract for Sale and Purchase of Natural Gas and will increase the efficiency and decrease the costs of trading NGL commodities by reducing the amount of time and resources required to negotiate contracts between companies. The agenda for the web course will include background on the development of the form contract and focus on administering the NAESB NGL Master Agreement by reviewing each of the 16 sections of the contract. In addition, the course will cover delivery confirmation and examples of special provisions.

FORMAT?

The course is an interactive web cast presentation.
